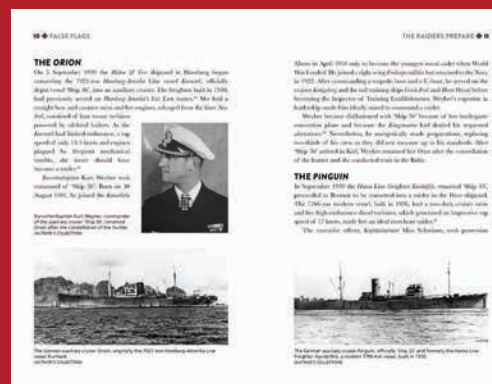


False Flags

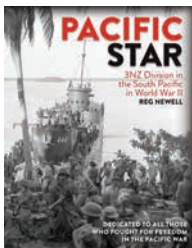

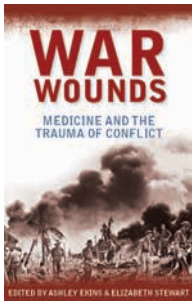
